Title/Position: Bus Monitor

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists with loading/unloading of students, including wheelchairs, making sure all equipment and medical paraphernalia (accessories) are properly stored and secured before the bus is moved.
- Is present at work every day, on time, and performs all duties as assigned effectively and efficiently.
- Is neat and professional in appearance following approved dress code policy.
- Exhibits a professional attitude and demeanor at all times in dealing with the board, school administration, fellow employees, parents, students, and the public.
- Assists with medical care of students.
- Communicates effectively and interact with students.
- Supervises seating arrangements.
- Assists with evacuation procedures.
- Drive a bus as needed.
- Follow federal and state laws, as well as school board policies.
- Works as a team with the bus driver.
- Attends training and meetings as requested or required.
- Other duties as assigned.
