SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST

Title/Position: School Psychologist

Retirement: Teacher Retirement System of Georgia

Terms of Employment: 190 Days

Reports to: Chief of Student Services

Qualifications: Valid Georgia certification on school psychology.

Evaluation: Performance of this job will be evaluated annually in accordance with provisions of the Board's Policy on evaluation.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Will evaluate and collate information on individual students to determine appropriate educational placement for the least restrictive environment.
- Administers psychological testing for special needs students to include the results concerning cognitive function, educational skills, social/emotional status, adaptive behavior competencies, and perceptual integration processes.
- Attends eligibility meetings and staffing's, as needed.
- Counsels students, when requested by principals, teachers, or parents.
- Observes students in classrooms, when deemed appropriate.
- Consults with teachers and parents, when appropriate.
- Develops program prescriptions, when requested.
- Conducts staff development concerning psychological evaluation instruments
 - and interpretations, when necessary.
- Performs other related tasks assigned by the Principal and other district administrators as designated by the Superintendent.
